



BJP to expose anti-reservation mindset of Congress: Singh

The Bharatiya Janata Party will "expose" the intention of the Congress to end reservation. Stating this, Lok Sabha member and BJP scheduled caste Morcha national general secretary, Bholu Singh alleged that statements made by Congress leader Rahul Gandhi in USA amount to denigrating the Dalit and backward sections in India in addition to denting the image of the nation. He should seek an apology from the nation for this, Singh said.



The Congress ruled the nation for 57 years and misused constitutional procedures for its own political gains. They never tried to implement the principles behind reservation in the real sense. The Congress government under Jawaharlal Nehru had rejected the Kaka Kalekar report on reservation for backward classes in 1956. They had worked to ensure BR Ambedkar's defeat in the Lok Sabha election of 1952 and 1954 to end his social

and political life. Indira Gandhi imposed the Emergency in 1975, crushing the soul of the constitution. The Congress made 25 amendments in the constitution from 1966 to 1977 for its own benefit. Apart from this, the Congress party also advocates provision of reservation for Muslims, which is against the constitution framed by Ambedkar. While Article 370 was in place, the Dalit community never got reservation in Kashmir but this never caused any both-

eration to the Congress," he said. Singh compared this to works done by the BJP governments at the Centre first under Atal Bihari Vajpayee and currently under Narendra Modi as the Prime Minister for the welfare of SC, ST and OBCs. He claimed that the BJP government at the Centre has been working consistently for the uplift of the deprived sections of society with considerable success also being achieved in this direction.

To ensure efficient assistance, it is required that complaints concerning the Department of Post are based on precise and thorough information. The officials have confirmed that this programme will take place this year as well. Public complaints related to postal services, particularly registry, parcels, BP, money

orders and savings bank, are welcomed for review in the upcoming court session until September 26. These complaints should be submitted, individually, in writing to the undersigned official at the Dehradun division, with 'Complaint for Postal Court' clearly stated at the top of the complaint letter. The officials further added that the postal court will not entertain complaints in the following scenarios: cases that the court has already resolved; cases currently in progress at the Consumer Forum; cases settled by the Directorate General of Posts; cases that the Postal Court has previously processed; or cases that lack clarity will not be accepted.

DAV college students seek increased police presence

The president of the student union at DAV PG College Siddharth Aggarwal informed that he has asked the Dehradun senior superintendent of police Ajai Singh to boost security measures on campus by increasing police personnel ahead of the student union elections. This move comes after a recent clash between student groups, which escalated to the point where police had to intervene with a lathi charge to restore order.

Aggarwal informed it occurred when a group of external students visited the college and got into a dispute with a few current DAV students. The dispute initially centred around student union elections but eventually led to a violent clash. Police arrived at the scene to address and resolve the situation, he said.

shown any concern or taken any action to enhance security measures on campus. Regarding this matter, the college principal, SK Singh said that a police post has been established on the college premises to address and monitor any such incidents.

he called upon the local administration to handle the matter responsibly, he said.

Notably, an altercation was reported on Friday involving two groups of students at DAV PG College. Following a heated argument, the situation escalated into violence prompting immediate intervention from police officials. To prevent further escalation, the police resorted to a lathi charge.

He further expressed his concern regarding the incident of violence prior to the election, which poses a threat to the safety and security of the college students. To prevent similar situations in the future, they have requested the SSP of Dehradun to increase the police presence at the college to ensure that unauthorised individuals do not disrupt the college environment.

Commenting about violence before the student union election, a retired professor of Shri Guru Ram Rai (SGRR) University, Atul Gupta highlighted the issue, attributing it to impatience, intolerance and dominance among students. He commended the government's decision to implement a 'one day, one election' process for student union elections as a measure to reduce violence compared to past years.
