Apart from this, light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places in all districts of the State today.

ain and hail across the State partly to generally cloudy sky. Light to moderate rain/thunderstorms accompanied with lightning/hail and gusty winds (30-40 kmph) are also likely to occur. The maximum and minimum temperatures are likely to be about 31 degrees Celsius and 17 degrees Celsius respectively in Dehradun on Saturday.

Meanwhile, the maximum and minimum temperatures recorded in various parts of the State on Friday were 31.6 degrees Celsius and 16.9 degrees Celsius respectively in Dehradun, 32 degrees Celsius and 18.9 degrees Celsius in Pantnagar, 22 degrees Celsius and 7.4 degrees Celsius in Mukteshwar and 22.8 degrees Celsius and 11.1 degrees Celsius in New Tehri.

The maximum temperature was a degree below normal in Dehradun while in Pantnagar, the maximum was three degrees below normal with the minimum being three degrees above normal. The minimum temperature was two degrees below normal in Mukteshwar. The maximum was three degrees below normal while the minimum was a degree below normal in New Tehri

Warning- intense spells | CM directs DMs to address drinking water shortage

Dhami has instructed all district magistrates to identify areas suffering from drinking water shortage and to prepare action plans for supplying water to these places. He said this while chairing a review meeting with the DM's on Friday, focusing on the provision of drinking water during the summer months.

Dhami emphasised the need for officials to accelerate plans for ensuring drinking water supply through pipelines to every village and city in the State, quickly replace malfunctioning tubewells, maintain fire hydrants, ensure afforestation and construction of check dams in catchment areas. He stressed on coordination with Stream and River Rejuvenation Authority (SARRA) to revive water sources and develop a policy for water enrichment. Additionally, he highlighted the importance of utilising solar pumps to ensure water supply in remote areas.

Based on the Meteorological department's forecasts of extreme heat this year, he reiterated that all district magistrates should identify locations with drinking water shortage and devise a strategy to address the issue. He also encouraged spreading messages about water conservation through schools, Panchayats and social media. To mitigate the impact of forest fires during the summer, Dhami called for the in-

Additionally, he suggested implementing a GPS-enabled system for monitoring tankers to improve the management of water deliveries and establish regulated rates

for private tankers. Dhami announced plans for constructing small dams and barrages to capture rainwater, preventing wastage and ensuring sustainable water use during the summer. He said that the DMs should identify mit proposals within three weeks. Further, he informed about the intention to build a series of check dams in the districts. He highlighted that in many mountainous regions, water is still transported by horses and mules and he called for a long-term plan to address these specific challenges.

The Congress staged a protest against the condition of the Ut-▲ tarkashi district hospital and alleged negligence in prepara-

tions for the Char Dham Yatra here on Friday. The district Congress chief Manish Rana led a party delegation which submitted a memorandum addressed to the governor. In the memorandum submitted to the district magistrate Meharban Singh Bisht, the party has stated that the Uttarkashi district hospital lacks specialist doctors. There is only one physician while there is no orthopaedic. Further, important services like ultrasound and CT scan are not available round the clock as required in a district hos-

There is a major shortage of important medicines in the Jan Aushadhi Kendra, due to which the citizens are forced to purchase expensive medicines from chemists outside the hospital. The Congress also alleged that touts are thriving in the district hospital with patients being intentionally referred to or sent to private pathology labs and medical stores. The citizens are being openly exploited at the district hospital, which will not be tolerated anymore, they said.Rana said that such a pathetic condition of the district hospital and health services in a border district like Uttarkashi which is also vulnerable to disasters, is akin to playing with the lives of the citizens.

He sought appointment of specialist doctors, round the clock diagnostics, regular supply of essential medicines and action against corruption. All the pending works on the Yatra route should also be completed without any further delay, he said.
