Sensex Soars Over 1,300 Points, Nifty Nears 22,800 Mark; Tariff Relief Fuels Market Surge

Benchmark Indian equity indices witnessed a sharp rally in early trade on Friday after the United States announced a 90-day suspension of additional tariffs on Indian exports. The decision, effective until July 9, provided a significant boost to investor sentiment, propelling the Sensex and

Nifty to substantial gains. The 30-share BSE Sensex surged by 1,236.64 points to reach 75,083.79, while the broader NSE Nifty jumped 415.70 points to 22,814.80. The market rally came after the White House confirmed the temporary suspension of punitive tariffs imposed under a sweeping trade action announced by US President Donald Trump on



April 2. Earlier this month, Trump had levied universal duties on exports from around 60 countries, including India. The move involved steep tariffs on various products such as shrimp and steel, which threatened to impact India's

trade with the world's largest economy. The sudden tariff freeze has now calmed nerves on Dalal Street, at least for the short term. Among the top gainers from the Sensex pack were Tata Motors, Sun Pharma, Tata Steel.

Google lays off hundreds of employees in Android, Pixel, and Chrome teams: Report

Google laid off hundreds of employees from the platforms and devices unit, which works on the Android software, Pixel phones and the Chrome browser. This cut comes after the tech giant's January buyout offers to employees in the unit, according to a report by The Information. HT.com cannot independently verify the authenticity of the information contained in the report. "Since combining the Platforms and Devices teams last year, we've focused on

becoming more nimble and operating more effectively and this included making some job reductions in addition to the voluntary exit program that we offered in January," the report quoted a Google spokesperson as having said. This also comes after Google laid off employees in its cloud division in February, though it said that the job cut round affected only a few teams, according to a Bloomberg report. Google in January 2023, had announced plans to cut as many as 12,000 jobs, which amounts to 6% of its global workforce.

Chinese stocks show resilience despite Trump's 145% US tariffs

Chinese shares maintained relative composure after the US said tariffs on China amounted to 145%, signaling continued focus on Beijing's stimulus plans. A key gauge of Hong Kong-listed Chinese stocks swung between a loss 0.9% and a gain of 0.5% on Friday. The onshore CSI 300 Index saw modest declines. Both outperformed a broader Asian market gauge that fell as much as 2.1%. The range-bound trading came after the White House

clarified Thursday that after including a 20% levy imposed earlier this year, the total tariffs on China stand at 145%, a level far above what many economists said could decimate US-China trade. Now all eyes are on the outcome of a Thursday meeting planned by China's top leaders to discuss additional economic stimulus to counter the impact of an escalating trade war. Sentiment in China's onshore market stayed resilient despite higher US tariffs, according to Morgan Stanley.

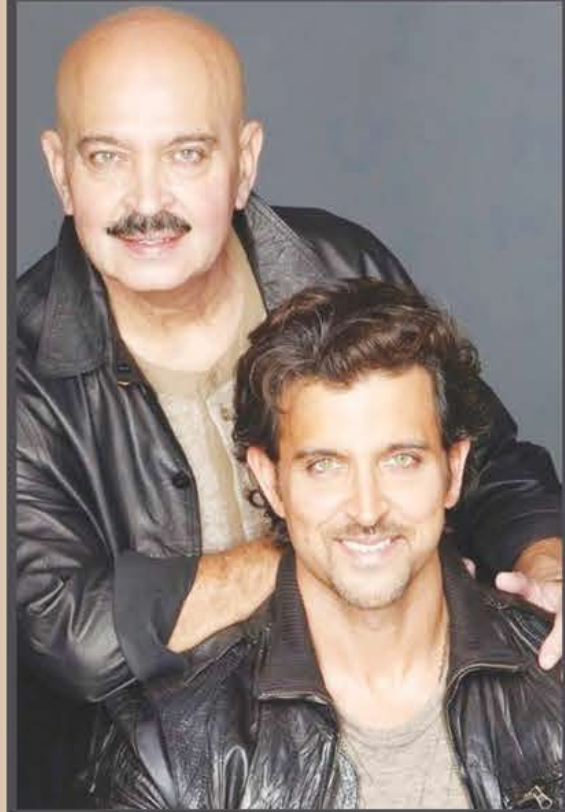
