Central government makes major changes in National Security Advisory Board

The central government, which woke up after the Pahalgam attack, has carried out a major purge in the National Security Advisory Board. Former RAW chief Alok Joshi has been appointed as the chairman of the board. Six other members have also been appointed to the board. Former Air Commander Air Marshal PM Sinha, former Army Commander Lieutenant General AK Singh and Rear Admiral Monty Khanna have also been included in the board. This decision was taken in a CCS meeting called at Narendra Modi's house after the Pahalgam attack. Alok Joshi's performance when he was RAW chief was excellent. He is considered an expert in intelligence matters. When he is in RAW, he led some important secret operations. The government is holding some high-level meetings on the issue of the Pahalgam terrorist attack. The opposition has declared that they are with the government. NCP (Sharad Pawar) president Sharad Pawar has also supported the government. Pawar has said, 'We support the steps that Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his colleagues will take.' Changes in metro train timings due to IPL to be held in Ahmedabad

GMRC has decided to change the timings of Metro Train due to the IPL 2025 match to be held at Narendra Modi Cricket Stadium in Ahmedabad. The current timings of Metro Train services for the match to be held at Narendra Modi Cricket Stadium on May 2 i.e. today and May 14 are from 6:20 am to 10 pm. Which has been extended till 12:30 am. The last train from Motera Metro Station will depart at 12.30 pm. The current metro train timings in Ahmedabad are from 6.20 am to 10 pm. But due to the IPL match to be held at the Narendra Modi

Cricket Stadium, the number of passengers may increase. Then, the metro train will run till 12.30 am to avoid any inconvenience to the passengers. However, on the return journey, you can board the metro only from Motera Stadium Metro Station and Sabarmati Metro Station. From Motera, you can get down at any station in APMC and from Thaltej village, you can get down at any station in Vastral village. The last train will leave from Motera Metro Station at 12.30 pm. The fare of special paper ticket will be Rs 50 per person. However, this fare will be applicable after 10 pm. Till then, passengers will be able to travel with regular fare. After 10 pm, only special paper tickets will be valid for entry into Motera Stadium and Sabarmati Metro Station.
