CM mocks Chandy's Vizhinjam legacy, says it's not enough to lay foundation

Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Wednesday sneered at the contribution of the Oommen Chandy government in the Vizhinjam International seaport project. "It is not just enough to lay the foundation stone. The world's biggest ships are now docking at Vizhinjam," the Chief Minister told reporters.

"It is not by pushing any ordinary boat into the waters that we are going to inaugurate the port," Pinarayi said with a tongue-incheek smile, a sly reference to the CPM's oft-repeated charge that the Chandy dispensation



had, during its last days, gone on an inauguration spree of even

half-complete projects. Just an hour before, Minister for Ports V

N Vasavan also had used the same gag line to undermine the Congress's claim that the Vizhinjam project was Chandy's vision. "The foundation was laid, but the Chandy government did nothing more," Vasavan said. Both the Chief Minister and

the ports minister said that one of the world's largest shipping companies, Shipping (Mediterranean Company), had included Vizhinjam port in its Jade Service, which meant that the Vizhinjam port was now connected to all major global ports.

"Vizhinjam has now emerged as the face of South India's cargo movement," the CM said.

Then, as if taking a statesmanlike approach, the Chief Minister said that it had to be understood that the project was not the discovery of this government or the Chandy government before it. "This is the fruition of a process that had begun decades ago," he said. But he was clear which stretch in the process was the most important. Chandrayaan-3 APXS measures volatile elements in South Polar region

Chennai, Apr 30 (TSIT) Scientists of the Physical Research Laboratory (PRL), Ahmedabad have analysed the concentrations of volatile elements measured at Shiv Shakti statio near the South Polar Region, using the Alpha Particle X-ray Spectrometer (APXS) onboard the Pragyan rover of the Chandrayaan-3 mission.

A comparison of the APXS measured abundances with the other available data revealed anomalous depletion in sodium and potassium, but enrichment in sulfur in the soils at the highland landing site.

This study published in the journal Nature Communications Earth and Environment has revealed potential presence of primitive lunar mantle materials at the landing site, which was excavated during formation of the South Pole-Aitken (SPA) basin 4.3 Ga ago and redistributed by subsequent impacts on the SPA basin ejecta.

The primitive mantle contributed the excess sulfur, which got mixed up with the materials at the landing site, ISRO said in a update on Wednesday.

The low levels of sodium and potassium at the landing site suggests that the KREEP (potassium, rare earth elements,

and phosphorus) might not have existed at the place and time of SPA basin formation. This new finding makes the Chandravaan-3 landing site a promising site to access primitive mantle samples, which is otherwise lacking in the existing lunar collec-On 23 August 2023, the tions. Chandrayaan-3 mission marks the first successful landing in the South Polar Region of the Moon. The Alpha Particle X-ray Spectrometer (APXS) aboard Pragyan rover directly measured the elemental composition of the Moon's surface at unexplored location, i.e., Shiv Shakti statio located at 69.37 deg S, 32.32 deg E in the southern high-latitude highlands of the nearside of the Moon. The APXS measurement of major elements supported the lunar magma ocean (LMO) hypothesis. It also provided clues for the presence of lower crust and/or upper mantle materials at the landing site. The APXS also measured abundances of volatile elements, including sodium, potassium, and sulfur in the highland soils, and reported varied concentrations ranging from 700-2800 ppm, 300-400 ppm, and 900-1400 ppm, respectively. Scientists from the PRL have made a detailed analysis of the abun-

dances of these volatile elements.
